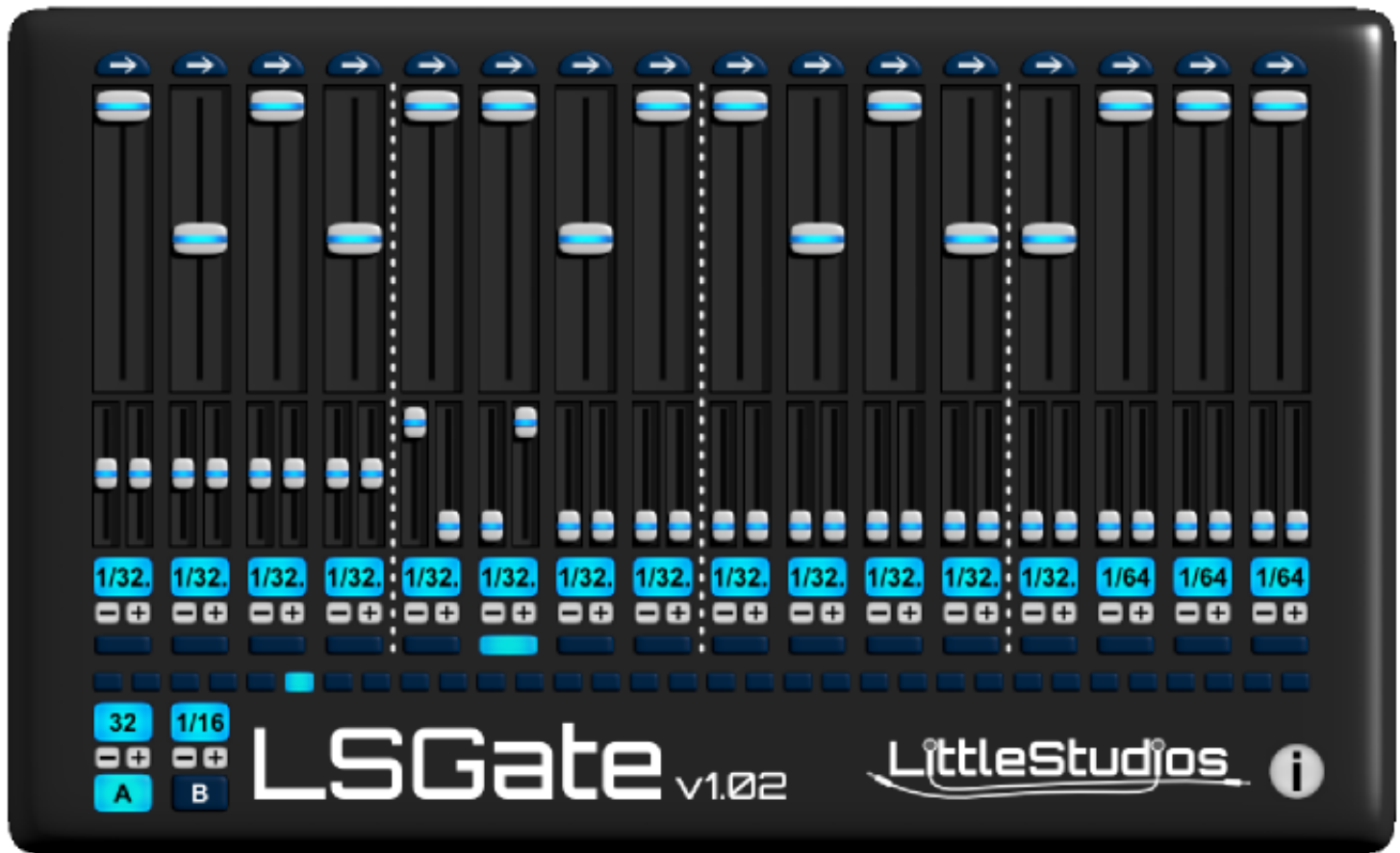

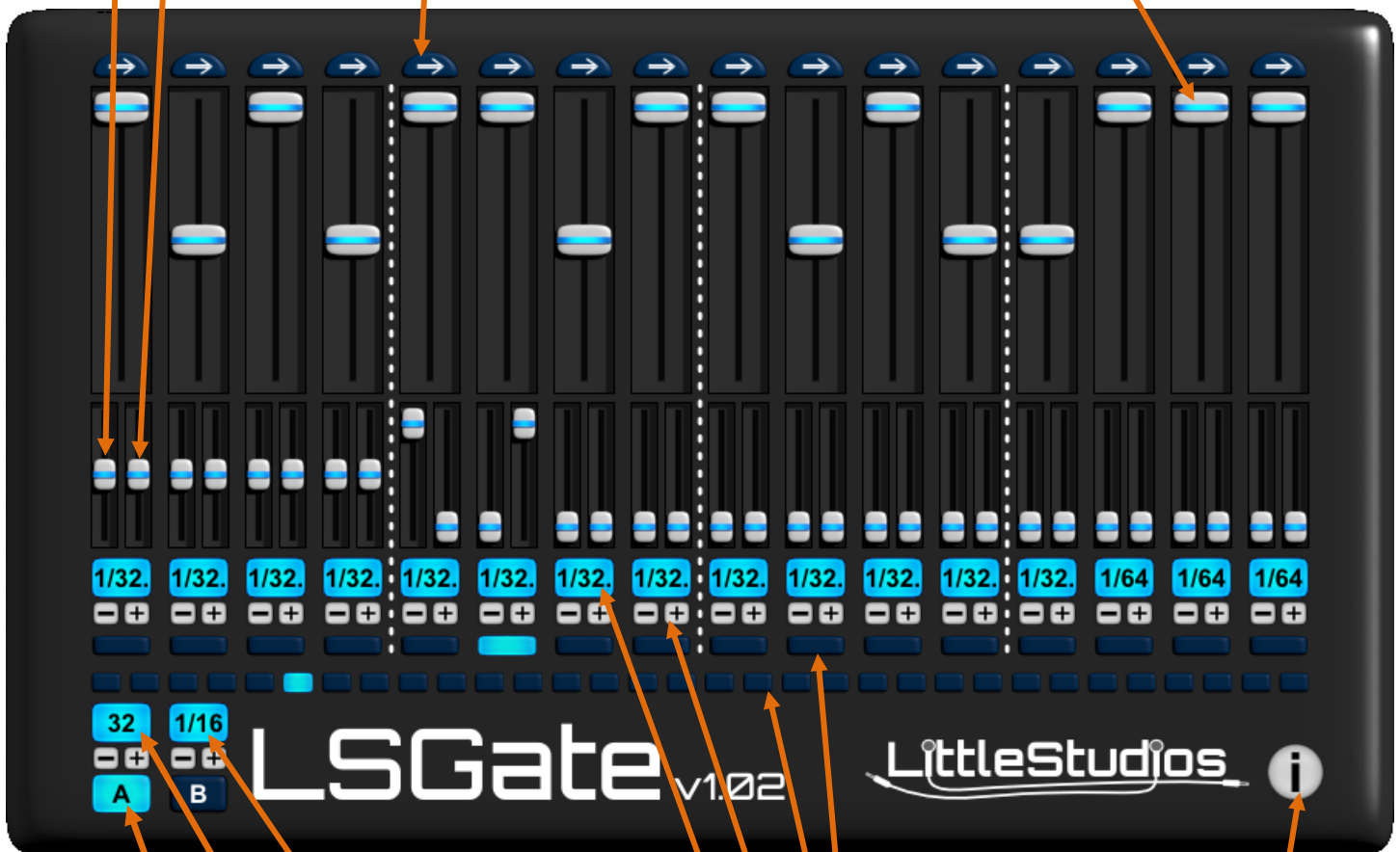
This plugin allows you to smoothly transition from one step to the next. Simply enable the merge button. Instead of fading to a volume of zero, it will now fade up or down to the volume of the next step. The decay of the current step fades to the volume of the next. Also the attack of the next step fades in from the current step.

The Merge button is automatically enabled if the Note Length matches the Step Length. Also it is automatically disabled if the Note Length is less than the Step Length. Merge can be manually disabled by clicking the Merge button off and re-enabled by clicking it on.

Attack time of current step

Sets the volume of each step.



Sets the step length in musical notes.

Sets the number of steps.

There are 2 pages of 16 steps. These toggle between the pages (A & B).

Brings up the about screen

Current step indicator

Overall current step indicator

Increase or decrease value above

Sets the audible length in musical notes. This will never be longer than the step

Functionality

LSGate can be used with or without the transport playing. **Without** the transport playing, LSGate will sync with the host tempo. **With** the transport playing, LSGate will sync with the host tempo as well as knowing its current location in the pattern based on the host's location in the project (ex. Time Ruler location).

Copy & Paste

LSGate has the ability to Copy and Paste control values. Copy and Paste can be applied to the velocity faders and the step length and note length. Copy and Paste can only be applied between controllers of the same type.

To Copy value (ex. the velocity) simply **ctrl + right click** on the velocity fader.

To Paste the value to another controller simply **right click** on a controller of the same type (ex. velocity fader to velocity fader).

The default value of Paste is 0.0.
